This Certificate is issued for a reasonable quantity of indoor domestic use at one single family residence based on the household occupancy, and outdoor irrigation of 2,000 square feet of lawn or garden.

Commercial water use, industrial water use, and livestock watering are not covered by this Certificate.

Indoor domestic water use at one single family residence includes water used for drinking, bathing, sanitary purposes, cooking, and laundering and other incidental household uses. Incidental uses must minimize the consumptive use of water. Examples of incidental household uses include, but are not limited to: washing windows, car washing, cleaning exterior structures, care of household pets, and watering potted plants.

Water use must be from a well located within the Approved Mitigation Area as defined by Spokane County.

This Mitigation Certificate is issued pursuant to and subject to the Spokane County Stream Flow Mitigation Certificate Ordinance.

This Certificate solely relieves the risk of curtailment under WAC 173-555, the Little Spokane River Instream Flow Rule for water use consistent with the Certificate terms and limited to the above referenced parcel and abbreviated legal description, and is not transferable for use at other locations.
