**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHENEY  
TO SUBMIT A PROPOSITION OF RAISING REVENUES BY A SPECIAL  
LEVY FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO THE VOTERS OF  
THE CITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the anticipated revenue for 2019 is not deemed adequate for the necessary expense of the Cheney Fire Department providing emergency medical services, and

**WHEREAS**, the term "emergency medical services" means the provision of emergency medical care or emergency medical services including related personnel costs, training for such personnel, and related equipment, supplies, vehicles and structures necessary to provide such care (RCW 84.52.069(5)).

**WHEREAS**, RCW 84.52.069 provides for a regular levy for emergency medical care and services, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the City of Cheney City Council as follows:

Section 1. The question of whether the City Council shall levy a property tax for the purpose of emergency medical services be submitted to the voters.

Section 2. The BALLOT TITLE shall read:

PROPOSITION SUBMITTED BY THE CHENEY CITY COUNCIL FOR  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES – SIX YEAR LEVY

Shall the City of Cheney be authorized, pursuant to RCW 84.52.069, to renew regular property tax levies upon the taxable property within the City of Cheney at a rate of fifty cents [.50] per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for six consecutive years,


commencing in 2018 for collection in 2019 to provide for the uninterrupted continuation of funding for emergency medical services.


