DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Non-Project Action; Proposed amendment to Spokane County Shoreline Master Program. Authority for the periodic Review is based on Washington's Shoreline Management Act (Ch. 90.58 RCW) and related rules. These amendments were developed by Spokane County to comply with WAC 173-26-090, which requires all local governments to review their SMPs on an eight-year schedule set in state law, and revise it if necessary. The review ensures the SMP keeps up with changes in state law, changes in other County plans and regulations, and other changed circumstances.

Proponent: Spokane County Department of Building and Planning, 1026 W Broadway, Spokane, WA 99260

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The Shoreline Master Program (SMP) text and maps are applicable to unincorporated Spokane County in all areas meeting the definition of "shorelines of the state" as defined in Section 11 of the SMP, and detailed in Section 10 of the SMP, together with maps adopted as Appendix II of the SMP.

Lead agency: Spokane County Department of Building and Planning

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
