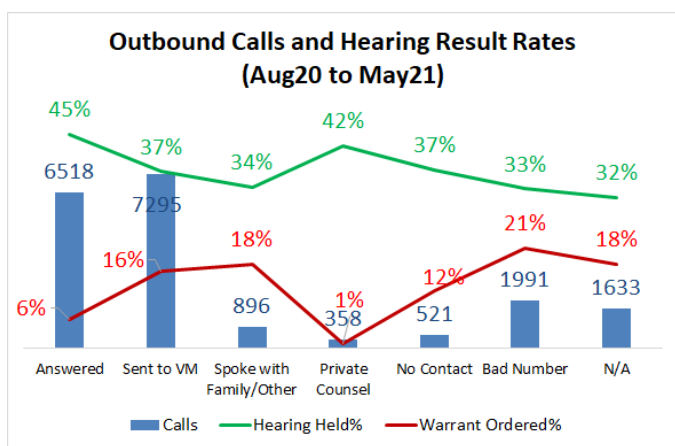

## Forthcoming Projects

*The following projects, funded by the MacArthur Foundation's Safety & Justice Challenge, are anticipated to launch before the end of 2021. Several other projects are currently in the planning phase with expected launch dates in 2022.*

### VICTIM SERVICES EXPLAINER VIDEO

This animated video will share information about available resources across the Spokane region for victims and survivors of crime.

### RIDESHARE INITIATIVE

This pilot project will provide free rides to court-related appointments for individuals in need of affordable and reliable transportation in order to 1) lift barriers to participation and 2) increase court appearance rates and system efficiency.

### RACIAL EQUITY IMPACT ASSESSMENT

This assessment will help criminal justice entities apply an equity analysis to planned projects and policies. A team of systems actors and community experts are leading the tool's development.

### MICROGRANT INITIATIVE

A selection committee comprised of community members and systems actors will award up to \$75,000 to community-based organizations tackling criminal justice challenges.
