WHEREAS, Resolution No. 67-25, passed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington, on the 10th day of January, 1967, adopted the "Spokane County Traffic Code"; and

WHEREAS, It is now apparent that the best interests of the public would be served by certain revisions to said Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, A Traffic Engineering Study has been made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington, that said Traffic Code be and the same is hereby revised and amended as follows:

	North Road Bridge over Dragoon Creek – Bridge No. 3806
MOTOR TRUCK SEMI- TRAILER TRUCK & TRAILER and SINGLE UNIT VEHICLE TRUCKS	36 Tons Max

	West Branch Road Bridge over West Branch Little Spokane River – Bridge No. 3906
MOTOR TRUCK SEMI- TRAILER TRUCK & TRAILER and SINGLE UNIT VEHICLE TRUCKS	36 Tons Max

The County Engineer is hereby directed and authorized to cause to be posted and maintained signs in accordance with this Resolution and the *Manual On Uniform Traffic Control Devices For The State Of Washington* as adopted by the Secretary of Transportation.
